Glossary of Key vocabulary

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Programming - the process or activity of writing computer programs: Quiz – a test of knowledge Algorithm - a process or set of rules to be followed in calculations or other problem-solving operations, especially by a computer.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Habitat – The natural habitat where an animals lives. Micro-habitat – A small area that is a different environment to the area around it. Food Chain – A series of animals that rely on each other for food. Survival – Continuing to live. Carnivore – An animal that only eats meat. Herbivore – An animal that only eats plans. Omnivore - An animal that eats plans and meat. Offspring – An animals or humans young.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Globe – The earth – a sphere. Map - a representation of an area of land or sea showing features. Compass - an instrument a magnetized showing the direction of north.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE: Basketball:</u></p> <p>Dribble- Bouncing the ball on the floor using one hand at a time while moving around the court. Pass- Throwing or handling the basketball to a teammate. Shot- An attempt at scoring by throwing the ball toward the hoop.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE: Cricket:</u></p> <p>Bowling - throwing the ball toward the wicket defended by a batter. Biography - an account of someone's life written by someone else. Researcher - a person who carries out scientific research. Significant - great or important.</p>
