

Mathematics

We will be identifying numbers through subitising, exploring how numbers are made and comparing amounts.

How can I help my child?

Playing board games with your child and focusing on talking about how they know the number on the dice and counting on the number of spaces.

Personal Social Emotional Development

It's up to me - Developing independence and responsibility along with developing ability to act independently, monitoring and evaluating own learning.

RSHE - To consider the patterns and routines of our day.

How can I help my child?

Talk to the children about their learning. Encourage the children to take responsibility for their belongings and getting ready for school where appropriate.

Physical Development

Dough Gym/ Finger Gym

PE - Our PE sessions are on a **Wednesday** (indoor) and **Friday** (outdoor).

How can I help my Child?

Practise the letter formation sent home on the back of the word lists.

Communication and Language

How can I help my child?

Encourage your child to retell the stories in the books that they read.

How can I help my child?

Continue to read and share books with your child.

Help them to learn the words on the word lists that are sent home.

Encourage your child to have a go at writing for instance shopping lists, adding labels to pictures they draw.

Understanding the World

We will be comparing the seasons through the changes we see on our welly walks. We will also be talking about celebrations and how light is used in these.

How can I help my child?

Talk about the Seasons and what happens when they change.

Discuss the celebrations your family have and how you plan for them and what you do.
