We will be looking at partitioning numbers (splitting into parts). We will be using the language of 'more than', 'fewer than' and 'an equal number' to describe how many objects there are in each set.

How can I help my child?

Continue to use opportunities to count and identify numbers on walks and around the home.
Play board games using a die to practise counting on and identifying numbers on a die.

How can I help my child?

Talk with your child about what they are good at and what things they need help with.
