

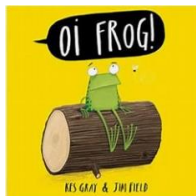
### Reading & Phonics

### Writing

**Y1:** Use a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces to form a sentence; know what an adjective is.

**Y2:** Write different sentence types using question and exclamation marks, expanded noun phrases, conjunctions.

### Maths

**Y1 Place Value:** Counting forward and backward from any number; read, write, order and compare numbers.

**Y2 Place Value:** Recognise tens and ones; read, write, order, compare and partition numbers to 100.

**Y1 Addition and Subtraction:** Recognising parts and wholes; number bonds within 10.

**Y2 Addition and Subtraction:** Number bonds to 10 and 100; add and subtract 1 and 10.
