## How have toys changed over time?

### **Maths**

- Place value within 10
- Addition within 10
- Subtraction within 10
- Using mathematical language to discuss our learning.

### **Science**

## Year 1 Autumn Term 1

### Learning Experience Key vocabulary 'Welcome to Toy Town'

As part of our learning experience this half term, for the subjects that are in focus as part of the connected curriculum, we will be focussing on learning, understanding and using the following key vocabulary. Some of these words we may have come across before, so this is an opportunity for us to revisit and consolidate our prior learning and some will be new to further develop our subject specific vocabulary. If you have any questions about the vocabulary, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher.

#### **Science**

Baby- A very young child, who is not able to walk.

Toddler- a young child who is just beginning to walk.

Child- A young person between the age of 3-12

Teenager- a person aged between 13 and 19 years

Adult- a person who is fully grown and mature; grown-up.

Elderly- Someone who is old or aging.

#### **Design & Technology**

Design- A plan or outline showing how something is to be built or carried out

Evaluate- Evaluating means judging the quality, value or relevance of something you've done

Purpose- something set up as an object or end to be attained

#### **Religious Education**

God- The Being perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness who is worshipped (as in Judaism, Christianity, Islam, and Hinduism) as creator and ruler of the universe.

Christianity- Christianity refers to the large group of religions who believe that the son of god was born a man - Jesus of Nazareth - over 2000 years ago.

Judaism- Judaism teaches that there is only one God and that God created the world. God expressed what he expects of people in the Ten Commandments and other laws. Jews believe that God chose them to have a special relationship with him.

#### **Physical Education**

Netball- Netball is a ball sport played by two teams of seven players. Games are played on a rectangular court with raised goal rings at each end. The object is to score goals from within a defined area, by throwing a ball into a hoop.

Football- It involves passing and kicking a ball. A football game is played between two teams of 11 players each. A team scores points by moving a ball across the other team's goal line into the net.

#### **Art**

Self-portrait- A self-portrait is a work of art, like a picture or a sculpture, that an artist has made of themselves.

Observational drawing- Observation Drawing means drawing what you see.
