<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Parts of a plant and trees- roots, flower, stem, leaves, trunk, branches, bulb, seeds</p> <p>Season- The seasons are four different times during the year with different types of weather.</p> <p>Identify- To know and say who someone is or what something is.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Continents- A continent is a large solid area of land. Earth has seven continents. In order from largest to smallest, they are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe, and Australia</p> <p>Oceans- ocean is a huge body of salt water. There is one world ocean, but it is divided into five main areas: the Pacific, the Atlantic, the Indian, the Arctic, and the Southern, or Antarctic.</p> <p>Body of water- A body of water or waterbody is any collection of water on a planet's surface. A body of water can be still (like a lake) or moving (like a river).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Design & Technology and Art</u></p> <p>Idea- a thought or opinion.</p> <p>Plan- A drawing or diagram showing the parts or outline of something.</p> <p>Evaluate- Evaluating is the process of deciding if something has been done in the best way and wondering what could be improved.</p> <p>Collage- A collage is a piece of art made from different pieces of paper, photos and other materials</p>

Something that happened or was done in the past.</p> <p>Famous- known about by many people.</p> <p>John Snow- was an English physician and a leader in the development of water and medical hygiene.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u></p> <p>Bowling - throwing the ball toward the wicket defended by a batter.</p> <p>Batter – the player who is currently trying to hit the ball</p> <p>Run - the unit of scoring</p> <p>Athletics- Athletics is the name given to a group of sports that includes track and field events.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>Covenant- is a formal agreement, a promise made between two people.</p> <p>God- The Being perfect in power, wisdom, and goodness who is worshipped (as in Judaism, Christianity, Islam, and Hinduism) as creator and ruler of the universe.</p> <p>Commandments- The Ten Commandments can be understood as a moral guidebook which aim to explain how people should behave towards each other.</p>
