<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Digestion – the process of breaking down food</p> <p>System – Network of organs that help you digest and absorb nutrition from your food.</p> <p>Oesophagus – hollow, muscular tube that carries food and liquid from your throat to your stomach.</p> <p>Intestine (small and large) – winding muscular tube that are responsible for breaking down food.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Working scientifically vocabulary:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Ask relevant questions</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Explain</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Draw simple conclusions</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE : Gymnastics</u></p> <p>Balances - A static position which holds the body in a distinct shape.</p> <p>Coordination - The ability of your arms, legs and other body parts to move in a controlled way.</p> <p>Routine – A combination of movements or maneuvers on one apparatus displaying a full range of skills.</p> <p>Sequence – two or more skills which are performed together creating a different combination skill.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Basketball –</p> <p>Chest pass – A pass in which the ball is quickly propelled from the chest by the hands and arms</p> <p>Dribbling - Bouncing the ball on the floor continuously with one hand at a time</p> <p>Possession - When a player is holding, dribbling or passing the ball</p> <p>Space – The distance away from each other when the team is on the offensive (attacking).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Digital image – A digital image is composed of picture elements such as pixels.</p> <p>Cloning – parts of a photo can be removed or duplicated</p> <p>Recolouring – An effect to change the colour or filters on an image.</p> <p>Combining – Using copy and paste to combine elements of two images together.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Farming - harvesting and using naturals</p> <p>Industry – All businesses and factories that convert raw materials into goods or useful services</p> <p>Interdependence – People, places or countries who support and need each other</p> <p>Fair trade – A process used by organizations around the world to make sure that they buy and sell farm goods that have been produced from farms that pay a fair price to their farmers and for their materials</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>Sikh – A person who follows the religion of Sikhism.</p> <p>Khalsa – The Sikh community, 'the community of the pure'.</p> <p>Amrit ceremony – An initiation right for any new member of the Sikh religion.</p> <p>The 5ks – Symbols worn by Sikhs who have been initiated into the Khalsa</p>
