Maths

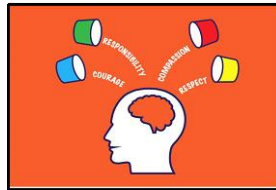
- Division dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by 1 digit.
