Glossary of Key vocabulary

As part of our learning experience this half term, we will be focussing on learning, understanding and using key vocabulary. Here are some of the words your children will be using. Some of these words we may have come across before, so this is an opportunity for us to revisit and consolidate our prior learning and some will be new, to further develop our subject specific vocabulary. This glossary will help you to support the children at home when they are talking about their learning.

<p><u>Art</u></p> <p><b>Line</b> - there are many different types of lines, all characterized by their length being greater than their width</p> <p><b>Shape</b> - defined as an enclosed area in two dimensions</p> <p><b>Form</b> – the visible shape or configuration of something</p> <p><b>Texture</b> - the feel, appearance, or consistency of a surface or substance.</p>	<p><u>PE: Tag Rugby</u></p> <p><b>Passing</b> – passes must be played level or backwards, the ball cannot travel forwards.</p> <p><b>Offside</b> – Attacking players must remain behind the ball when it is active.</p> <p><b>Tag</b> – To remove a tag of the opposition player who has the ball</p> <p><b>Dodging</b> – move passed the opponents with the ball.</p> <p><u>PE: Gymnastics</u></p> <p><b>Flexibility</b>- the quality of bending easily without breaking.</p> <p><b>Strength</b>- the quality or state of being physically strong.</p> <p><b>Control</b>- To exercise restraint or direction</p> <p><b>Technique</b>- A technique is the way of performing a skill e.g. skill – passing; technique – chest pass.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p><b>Pitch</b> - highness or lowness of sound</p> <p><b>Tempo</b> - the rate of speed at which a musical piece or passage is to be played or sung</p> <p><b>Dynamics</b> - variation in force or intensity in a piece of music)</p> <p><b>Structure</b> - the arrangement or relationship of elements of a piece of music</p>
<p><u>French</u></p> <p><b>les vêtements</b> - the clothes</p> <p><b>un pantalon</b> a pair of trousers</p> <p><b>un pull</b> a jumper</p> <p><b>un manteau</b> a coat</p> <p><b>une robe</b> a dress</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>System</p> <p>Input</p> <p>Output</p> <p>Process</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p><b>Incarnation:</b> God becoming man or literally being “made flesh</p> <p><b>Gospel:</b> the first 4 books of the New Testament about Jesus’ life, ministry and death, and the early Church.</p> <p><b>Disciples:</b> Jesus’s special friends.</p> <p><b>Forgiveness:</b> an intentional decision to let go of resentment and anger.</p>
