As part of our learning experience this half term, we will be focussing on learning, understanding and using key vocabulary. Here are some of the words your children will be using. Some of these words we may have come across before, so this is an opportunity for us to revisit and consolidate our prior learning and some will be new, to further develop our subject specific vocabulary. This glossary will help you to support the children at home when they are talking about their learning.

<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Reproduction - the production of offspring</p> <p>Life processes - are those processes which is necessary to maintain life in an organism</p> <p>Vary – to differ in size, amount, degree, or nature from something else</p> <p>Life cycles (recap y3) - the series of changes in the life of an organism including reproduction.</p> <p>Classification (recap y3) - a category into which something is put.</p>	<p><u>PE: Stoolball</u></p> <p>Catching – the art of receiving the ball</p> <p>Striking – hitting the ball with a bat</p> <p>Fielder – member of the team who stands out away from the bowler and striker to try to catch the ball</p> <p>Post – the item equipment that the striker runs to, this must be hit with the ball to get the striker out.</p> <p><u>PE: Athletics</u></p> <p>Target – where you are aiming to throw or run towards</p> <p>Obstacle – a task to complete during a race</p> <p>Accuracy – trying to be precise with aim when throwing</p> <p>Stamina – the ability to keep going</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Climate change – the effect human actions are having on temperatures and rainfall</p> <p>Biodiversity – the range/variety of plants and creatures in an area</p> <p>Citizenship – being part of the local and global community</p> <p>Human and physical geography – differences between manmade and natural features of the environment</p>
<p><u>French</u></p> <p>la prairie - the meadow</p> <p>l'océan - the ocean</p> <p>le désert - the desert</p> <p>l'Arctique - the Arctic</p> <p>l'Amazonie - the Amazon</p> <p>...est un habitat dans - ..is a habitat in...</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Recording - filming on a device</p> <p>Editing – add or remove parts of the film or add effects</p> <p>Creating – to make something as per your design brief</p> <p>Shot types – changing recording angle or distance to add interest to the film</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>The 5 Ks – Items that the Khalsa Sikhs wear to show their commitment</p> <p>Guru – a religious leader or teacher</p> <p>Guru Nanak – the man who started Sikhism</p> <p>Gurdwara – Sikh place of worship</p> <p>Guru Granth Sahib – The Sikh holy book, Sikhs think of it as a living Guru</p>
