Retrieval and inference, building reading stamina and developing skimming and scanning techniques.

Place Value: Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000,000 and determine the value of each digit.

Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division: Consolidate and extend use of formal written and mental methods using all four operations to include whole numbers and decimals.

Writing as an inanimate object: use external features, to describe their internal world (thoughts, feelings, motivations).

Blend action, dialogue and description across paragraphs.
